

DIVISION IMPROVEMENT

1. A candidate who has passed the B.A./B.Sc./B.Com.(General)/BBA/BCA/Honours course examination from the University of Jammu and has been placed in the second division in the aggregate of all the semester examinations shall be given one chance to improve his/her division within a period of two years of having passed the B.A./B.Sc./B.Com.(General)/BBA/BCA/Honours course examination and for this purpose he/she shall appear as a private candidate in the consecutive examinations in any number of courses except Practicals, field work, surveys, viva-voce etc. The marks already earned by the candidate in other courses in which he/she does not appear shall be carried forward. The result of such a candidate shall be declared if he/she improves the division.
2. Reappearance in Practical examination shall not be allowed.
3. A student who appears in a paper shall carry forward the internal assessment marks originally awarded.

Notwithstanding anything contained above, a candidate, who having passed the B.A./B.Sc./B.Com.(General)/BBA/BCA/Honours course examination in second division with less than 50% marks from the University of Jammu, appears in the examination to improve the division but fails to do so, his/her result may also be declared provided he/she secured 50% marks or above.

Such a candidate shall have to return to the University the Graduation Degree and marks transcripts of all semester examinations, in original, if issued to him/her. The certificates will be returned to him/her if he/she fails to improve his/her result under the above provisions.
