27-10-2010: A two-day State Level Workshop on "**Effective Research : Theory and Practice**" was inaugurated by Ch. Lal Singh, member Parliament Udhampur-Kathua Range organized by Internal Quality Cell(IQAC) of the College in association with English Language Teachers' Association of India (ELT@I). The aim of the workshop was to provide a platform to the teachers of English to know more about making their research publications more effective. Prof. Posh Charak, HoD English and Director Centre for New Literatures, University of Jammu presided over the inaugural session whereas Sh. Krishan Chander Bhagat, Hon'ble MLA Chenani,

Seminar on “Democracy and Gender in India” organised

18-01-2011: Dept. of Political Science and Dept. of Sociology jointly organized one day seminar on “Democracy and Gender in India” today in the college conference hall. Principal Prof.(Dr) Nutan K Resutra presided over the proceedings. Prof (Dr) Rekha Chowdhary, Head Dept. Of Political Science, Jammu University, (Prof) Abha Chohan Head, Dept. of Sociology, JU and Dr. Garima Gupta from Shri Mata Vaishno Devi University were the resource persons. In his speech Dr. Nutan Kumar Resutra said that India is a democratic state and hence provides equal rights to everyone irrespective of caste, creed, region or faith. He implored upon the students to prepare themselves from within to create a society where both the genders live with mutual support .The seminar was specially planned for the male students of the college to sensitize them on gender issues vis-à-vis democracy

Prof.(Dr.) Rekha Chowdhary traced the psyche of women for their helplessness “weakness and incapability” that is induced since their childhood . “Given a chance women can prove their worth. Democracy is not gendered but culture makes it so. Patriarchy is so embedded in our psyche that we all, both the genders, will have to work very hard. Aware society is an essential feature of a healthy democracy. Reservation of women, assertion for their rights and identity and curbing cultural prejudices are the essential steps towards creating an egalitarian society”, she said. A healthy interaction followed the presentation in which the staff and students actively participated..

Prof. Abha Chouhan in her presentation said that any democracy is thought to be functional when views and perspectives of all its citizens are equally honoured.” Absence of women from decision making makes the system biased. People who are gender sensitive matter in a democracy. Women reservation in politics is a viable measure to ensure gender justice,” she added. Touching upon the state of J & K , she said that to be a viable democratic state, it has to avail of its special status and be a leader to ensure gender equality in the country”, she added.

Dr. Garima Gupta said that it is not the right to vote but opportunity to vote that ensures equality among genders. “In a patriarchal set up, not only women but men also suffer. A woman is not born but made by her cultural orientation”, she added. Speaking about proposed Permanent Resident Bill of the J & K, she said that owning property makes women a part of economic system, hence enabling them to partake in decision making.” PRC Bill makes our democracy gendered”, she asserted.

Earlier the programme began with lighting the ceremonial lamp followed with welcome address by Prof. Rashmi Sharma , HOD Political Science of the host college. Prof. Shreeya , HOD Sociology conducted the proceedings and proposed a vote of thanks.

History and Culture of Sudh Mahadev ---A Report

Sudh Mahadev is a famous tourist spot in the Jammu region of the J&K, especially among the nature lovers and pilgrim tourists. Geography students have more details in a special report for us.....

Sudh Mahadev is situated at an altitude of 1225 meters above sea level. This holy spot is about 55 kms away from district headquarter Udhampur. Sudh Mahadev is well connected through mettle road with Udhampur city. Besides government buses some private transport also ply from Jammu and from Udhampur. As the story goes the sacred temple of Sudh Mahadev was constructed by Chaudhari Ramdas of Chenani and his son Chaudhari Parag Mahajan about 80 years ago (1931). Shri Masu Shahane of Sudh Mahadev is said to have constructed the main gate of the Sudhmahadev. The temple has a nature black oval shaped marble (Lingum) and Goddess Parvati mounted on Nandi Maharaj. The sacred fire (Dhooni) commemorates the spiritual attainments of Baba Roop Nath who is said to have attained Samadhi there. It is said to have been burning constantly ever since Baba Roop Nath is said to be residing in the temple. His disciple attained Samadhi after him in the same temple while standing.

According to a popular legend, it is believed that lord Shiva who was in his Samadhi shot his big "trishul" to protect his consort Uma whose loud cry shook Shiva out of his meditation. In fact Shiva's devotee Sudheet approached Uma to pay his respectful obeisance. Since he was a demon in his previous birth, according to the legend, his domestic looks frightened her and she made a loud shriek. The big trident which lord Shiva had flung hit Sudheet. Shiva realized his mistake and offered to resuscitate him. But Sudheet felt there could be no better life than death given by lord Shiva himself. Lord Shiva then gave his command that Sudheets name will be prefixed to his name at that place. Since the holy spot is known as Sudh Mahadev. The broken trident in three pieces is installed in the temple. Sudh Mahadev had a spring by the name Pap Nashni Bowli. It is believed that taking bath in it relieves a devotee of all sins. Generally pilgrims visit the shrine on historic Sudh Mahadev three day festival (Mela) on the full moon night of "Sawan" (June- July) to worship and the trident and mace.

Climatically Sudh Mahadev is cold in winter and mild in summer. The mean minimum and mean maximum temperature during the summer reads to 10°C and 25°C. Winter is cold and chilly and mercury dips to -10°C. The holy place receives moderate snow fall in the winter and normal to heavy rainfall in the rainy season. The area is well under the influence of south-west monsoon. Settlements are dispersed in pattern and main occupation of the people is farming. Mantalai, another of the twin tourist spots of the area is 8 kms from Sudh Mahadev. Located at the top of a hill it is surrounded by tall Deodar trees giving fresh cool air. It is believed that Lord Shiva and Goddess Parvati got married there. There is

a Shiv temple with a pond by its side. Gauri Kund is a legendary spring where the goddess Parvati used to bathe before starting her daily prayers at Sudh Mahadev. A annual festival(locally famous as Suddhi Da Mela) is organised every year on the full moon day of .Because of its bounties of natural surroundings , majestic mountains,hospitable inhabitants and socio-religious importance, this place is gaining popularity as a tourist spot. There is a need to develop and promote this place which has a tremendous potential of raising economic status of the area.
