

## **SCHEME OF EXAMINATION**

The scheme of examination for each Semester of B.A./B.Sc./B.Com.(General)/BBA/BCA shall be as under:-

### **(A) B.A./B.Sc.**

In each Semester a candidate shall opt four subjects including General English and the scheme of examination in each subject shall be as under :-

- i) General English shall consist of one written paper carrying 100 marks out of which 80 marks shall be for the External Examination and 20 marks for Internal Assessment.
- ii) Subject(s) not involving practicals including Mathematics shall consist of one written paper carrying 100 marks out of which 80 marks shall be for the External Examination and 20 marks for Internal Assessment. The paper will be set for 80 marks in each Semester.
- iii) Subject(s) involving practicals (other than Indian Music) shall consist of one written paper carrying 100 marks out of which 80 marks shall be for the External Examination and 20 marks for Internal Assessment and 50 marks for practical examination out of which 25 marks shall be for External Examination and 25 marks for Internal Examination (including lab./field work/project report etc. wherever prescribed).
- iv) In Indian Music, there shall be one paper of 40 marks out of which 30 marks shall be for External Examination and 10 marks for Internal Assessment. 60 marks shall be prescribed for practicals out of which 30 marks shall be for Internal Examination and 30 marks for External Examination.
- v) The examination in the subject of Environmental Science shall be conducted in 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Semesters carrying 100 marks in each semester. However, the Evaluation will be done at college level and the awards of the same shall be forwarded to the Controller of Examinations as is done in case of Internal Assessment. The marks obtained shall be shown separately.
- vi) The duration of examination in theory papers shall be three hours and that of Practical shall be determined by the Board of Studies concerned.

### **B) B.Com.**

In each Semester a candidate shall offer six subjects including General English and the scheme of examination in each subject shall be as under :-

- i) General English shall consist of one written paper carrying 100 marks out of which 80 marks shall be for the External Examination and 20 marks for Internal Assessment.
- ii) Each Commerce subject shall consist of one written paper carrying 100 marks out of which 80 marks shall be for the External Examination and 20 marks for Internal Assessment.
- iii) The duration of examination in the papers shall be three hours.

**C) Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA)**

The scheme of examination for each Semester of the BBA shall be as under :-

- i) Each paper shall be of 100 marks out of which 80 marks shall be for the External Examination and 20 marks for Internal Assessment. Viva-voce examinations and Project report shall carry 50 marks each.
- ii) There shall be a job training spread over a period of 30 days after the termination of BBA Semester-IV examination in an Industrial/ Business/Commercial organisation on the specialization group of study to be allotted by the College concerned. After completion of the job training, a certificate of successful completion of training from the Head of the concerned organization shall be obtained and a project report on the training undergone shall be submitted by each student. There shall be a viva-voce examination on the project report submitted by the candidate.
- iii) The viva-voce examination shall be conducted jointly by one external and one internal examiner to be appointed by the University.
- iv) The duration of examination in theory papers shall be three hours.

**D) Bachelor of Computer Applications (BCA)**

The scheme of examination for each Semester of the BCA course shall be as under :-

- i) General English shall consist of one written paper carrying 100 marks out of which 80 marks shall be for the External Examination and 20 marks for Internal Assessment.

- ii) Mathematics shall consist of one paper of 100 marks out of which 80 marks shall be for External Examination and 20 marks for Internal Assessment.
- iii) There shall be two written papers related to the subject of Computer Applications carrying 100 marks each out of which 80 marks shall be for External Examination and 20 marks for Internal Examination.
- iv) There shall be a practical paper carrying 100 marks out of which 50 marks shall be for External Examination and 50 marks for Internal Examination.
- v) In Semester-VI, there shall be two written papers i.e. General English and Mathematics carrying 100 marks each out of which 80 marks shall be for External Examination and 20 marks for Internal Assessment. There shall be Project Work carrying 300 marks out of which 200 marks shall be for External Examination and 100 marks for Internal Assessment.
- vi) The duration of examination in theory papers shall be three hours and that of Practicals shall be determined by the Board of Studies concerned.
